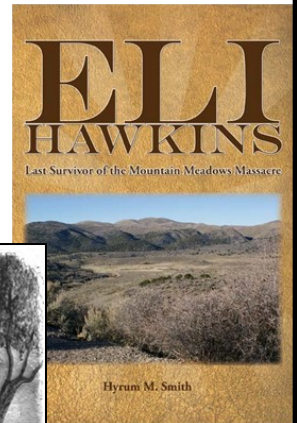
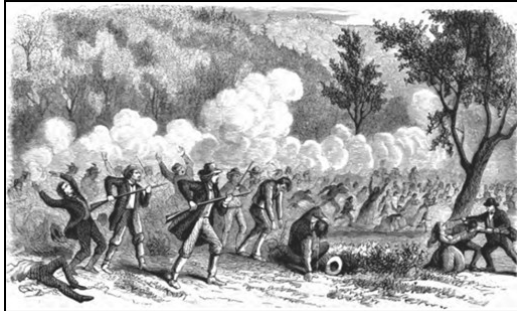

Mountain Meadows Massacre

Author Hyrum Smith will be here in person with a multi-media presentation about the history leading up to -and post- Mountain Meadows Massacre in 1857, in which over 100 Utah emigrants perished.

Smith has written a novel about a ten year-old boy who survives the attack which claimed his parents, and in which his sister is kidnapped by Indians. Framed by a huge Nevada silver strike, in this compelling story the Mormons, miners, and the Paiute Indians play integral roles in the massacre and its aftermath, which is interwoven with the true history of southern Utah, eastern Nevada, and northern Arizona. After his presentation, Smith will discuss and sign copies of the book, *Eli Hawkins, Last Survivor of the Mountain Meadows Massacre*.
